



The Dress Code for Students at Carcoola Primary School has been determined by the School Council in consultation with students, their parents and staff of the school.

RATIONALE

This school’s dress code supports all students to participate fully in school life. Dress codes help create a sense of identity and a school culture in which every student experiences a sense of belonging.

2.1 UNIFORM

The Carcoola Primary School Uniform has been identified as compromising of:

- ◆ CPS Polo shirt or alternative (navy blue)
- ◆ CPS Jacket or alternative (navy blue)
- ◆ Navy shorts, long pants, skorts/skirts
- ◆ Navy and white checked uniform style dress
- ◆ Leggings – plain navy; preferably to be worn under skorts/skirt, or appropriate shorts
- ◆ CPS Broad brimmed hat or alternative (plain navy blue)
- ◆ Closed in shoes (sneakers)
- ◆ Special T-Shirt for Graduating Students in Year 6

2.3 JEWELLERY/MAKE UP

For health and safety reasons, the wearing of jewellery is kept to a minimum

- ◆ Earrings; studs or small sleepers
- ◆ NO stretcher type earrings are permitted
- ◆ Watches are permitted
- ◆ Medical alert bracelets, necklaces or wrist bands are permitted
- ◆ SMART wristbands – no other wrist jewellery
- ◆ No make-up or nail polish is to be worn

2.4 HAIR

- ◆ Hair must be clean and brushed/combed
- ◆ Evidence of head lice must be treated before attending school.
- ◆ Hair should be combed off the face. Hair longer than collar length should be tied back.
- ◆ Fringes should be eyebrow length or clipped or tied back.
- ◆ Extreme hair styles are not permitted.

2.2 SPORTS UNIFORM

On Sports training days and school sporting events:

- ◆ Faction shirt
- ◆ Navy shorts, long pants, skorts
- ◆ Closed in shoes appropriate for running (eg. sneakers)
- ◆ Bathers should be modest: ie. one piece or full length rash shirt with shorts (board shorts)



2.5 ITEMS NOT PERMITTED UNDER THE DRESS CODE

- ◆ Any form of denim clothing, including shorts, jeans or jackets
- ◆ Make up (including nail polish)
- ◆ Jewellery which may cause a hazard (ie necklaces or bracelets other than medical alert)
- ◆ Stretcher type earrings
- ◆ Body piercing other than earrings
- ◆ Clothing with motifs or slogans
- ◆ Black clothing of any kind
- ◆ Peak caps or beanies
- ◆ Footwear which may impede students participation in class and outdoor activities (eg heavy boots, shoes with heels etc)
- ◆ Tattoos or body art
